Conditions of Entry

- All work must be the artist's original work and not a copy.
- Artists may submit up to **three** pictures.
- Each work must have **two** labels with artist's name, telephone no, title of work, medium, price or NFS (not for sale) – one label to be stuck on the back of work and the other on string long enough to hang below the frame. Please use HVL labels for hanging, available from the library.
- Submission fee per picture is £2 for a six-week period. Bona fide students will be exempt from this fee.
- Art work can be accepted and collected **only by appointment** with Peter McDonald:

- There will be a 20% commission on all work sold, deducted from the sale price.
- Every possible care will be taken of the artwork, but the library cannot be responsible for loss or damage; therefore insurance for artwork must be arranged by the artist.
- Minimum price shown for work is not to be less than £15.
- Artwork is not to be removed without the permission of the committee/organiser.
- Artwork, whether canvas or under glass, must be fitted with screw eyes or D rings and a tight wire or cord for hanging.
- Artwork will be hung by the committee and not the artist.
- The committee reserve the right not to hang work they consider unsuitable.
- Size of artwork, including frame, should not exceed 26" x 18" (66cm x 46cm).
- Artists must remove all wrapping/containers when their work is left with us.

Please make a note of the date when your painting, if not sold, must be removed.
